This is an indoor trial. The concrete floor is covered with new rubber matting. The facility has a large trial ring and a separate room for kenneling dogs. **All dogs will need to be crated and covered when not in the ring or prep area.** You will need to provide a protective surface under your kennel (such as cardboard, vinyl cloth, blanket, etc). We want to protect our new floor surface; therefore, your metal chairs should have rubber tips on all legs. **No dogs are allowed in the gallery seating areas.** The facility will open each day at 7:30 AM.

Entries must be postmarked by 03/12/2010 for discounted rate. Entries submitted via Federal Express or Express Mail will be accepted only if the signature waiver is signed. No telephone, e-mail, or fax entries will be accepted. Any changes to entries, including cancellations, will be accepted until 03/12/2010. Changes must be made to the Registrar (Bonnie Cipollone) by telephone (513-738-5278), e-mail (Bcipollone@fuse.net), or in writing. Cancellations received after 03/12/2010 will not be eligible for a refund of fees.

All dogs must be registered with C-WAGS to participate and receive credit in the C-WAGS classes. "For Exhibition Only" may enter but will receive no credit. Day of show registrations will be accepted prior to 10:30 AM if space allows. See C-WAGS registration form elsewhere in this premium.

Move-ups will not be allowed during this Trial.

Awards

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each team who qualifies. **Placement rosettes** will be awarded to the top 4 high scoring teams in each "A" class. **Placement ribbons** will be awarded to the top 4 high scoring teams in the "B" class. There will be a **raffle each day for NQ's** (non-qualifying scores). Junior handlers registered prior to 03/12/2010 will receive a participation gift.

The Kuliga Dog Training Club facility is at 898 Kieley Place in St. Bernard (within Cincinnati OH 45217), which lies between I-75 and I-71 off of OH route 562 (aka Norwood Lateral).

From I-75

1. Take I-75 to Exit #7 (OH-562/Norwood)
2. Take the Paddock Road exit. Go South (Right) off of the exit.
3. Turn Right at Tennessee Avenue which becomes Ross Avenue at Fischer Place.
4. Cross Fischer Place at the traffic light, then at the next street...
5. Turn Right onto Kieley Place.

From I-71...

1. Take I-71 to Exit #8A (OH-562/Norwood)
2. Take the Paddock Road exit. Go South (Left) off of the exit.
3. Turn Right at Tennessee Avenue which becomes Ross Avenue at Fischer Place.
4. Cross Fischer Place at the traffic light, then at the next street...
5. Turn Right onto Kieley Place.

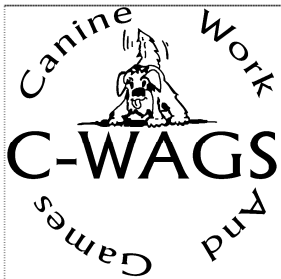
C-WAGS Notice to Exhibitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of C-WAGS Obedience & Rally rules and regulations including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- ♦ All exhibitors are expected to treat the judges, trial hosts, your canine partner and all other exhibitors with respect.
- ♦ All judges and trial hosts are expected to show respect to all exhibitors.
- ♦ This trial is open to all dogs registered with C-WAGS.
- ♦ Trial Hosts may elect to accept FOR EXHIBITION ONLY entries of non-registered dogs.
- ♦ Teams may be entered in multiple levels/classes at the same trial.
- ♦ Dogs must be shown by a member of the owner's immediate family.
- ♦ **Collars: The dog must wear a flat type collar (buckle, snap or proper fit martingale) and / or body harness in the ring.** Electronic training collars are not allowed on the show grounds. Slip, choke and prong collars are not allowed on the show grounds. Only one collar is permitted in the ring.
- ♦ **Handler may not wear pager or cell-phone, nor treat pouch in the ring.**
- ♦ Owners with disabilities are encouraged to compete. Any necessary modifications to the exercises must be provided by the handler to the judge and approved by the judge
- ♦ Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.

In addition,

- ♦ The organizing committee may refuse any entry for any reason.
- ♦ There shall be no refund for entries in the event a dog and / or handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. There will be prorated refunds if the trial has to be cancelled for any reason.
- ♦ Refunds will be made for females in season upon written request accompanied by a statement from the exhibitor's veterinarian.
- ♦ Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made by money order within 7 days of notice to exhibitor of returned check. Any fees not received within 7 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible.
- ♦ All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes.
- ♦ **Dogs must be on leash while on show grounds unless being shown.**
- ♦ **Dogs must be crated when not in the ring or in the prep staging area.**
- ♦ Move-ups from one class to another will not be allowed during this Trial.
